



This year alone, Luftfahrt ohne Grenzen / Wings of Help e.V. has sent nine trucks with essential aids to Greece to support people in refugee camps. Aid reached emigrants from the Middle East, Pakistan and Afghanistan in camps on Greek islands and on the mainland, such as here in the Kavala camp near Thessaloniki.

Immediate aid for Camp Moria and other refugee camps in Greece

Vital truck transports from Germany with baby food and clothing - Cooperation with "The Smile of the Child" and "Elpida"

The fate of the people from the destroyed Camp Moria, but also the hopeless situation of the people in other refugee camps, shocked. Their situation is not acceptable at all. Luftfahrt ohne Grenzen/Wings of Help e.V. will continue the help it has been providing for five years. Already now, in autumn, it is becoming apparent that humanitarian aid for people in need in Greece will be one of the priorities for the work of our organization in 2020.

According to official counts, there are at least 140,000 emigrants in Hellas - most of them live in camps on islands or near Piraeus and Thessaloniki. With the help of our local partners, The Smile of the Child in Athens and ELPIDA Home in Thessaloniki, immediate help is possible.

The first balance in 2020: We brought 240 tons of baby food, blankets, warm clothes, sturdy shoes, high chairs for toddlers and much more from Germany to Greece with nine trailer trucks.

Kurdistan: Masks from Germany against Corona



Luftfahrt ohne Grenzen/Wings of Help sent over 8,000 face masks to protect against Corona with a special flight from Iraqi Airways from Frankfurt to Erbil in the Kurdistan region. The masks are urgently needed in refugee camps where several thousand families especially from Syria are housed with children in particular have no protection against Corona. The distribution to the refugees was carried out on site by the partner Barzani Charity Foundation. The masks had been delivered to the “Hanke” refugee camp near Dohuk and the “Bab Alhaba” camp.

Surgical aid for children

Luftfahrt ohne Grenzen/Wings of Help e.V. has carried out several aid transports to Kurdistan in the past years and is returning to the region in autumn - among other things with a medical project to help children in refugee camps with surgery. The initiator is Dr. André Borsche from Interplast, chief physician for plastic surgery at the Diakonie Hospital in Bad Kreuznach. Dr. Borsche has received several high awards in the past for his strong commitment to children's aid projects in developing countries. Our organization has already worked with him on several projects.

Aid is on the road in the Rhine-Main-Region
